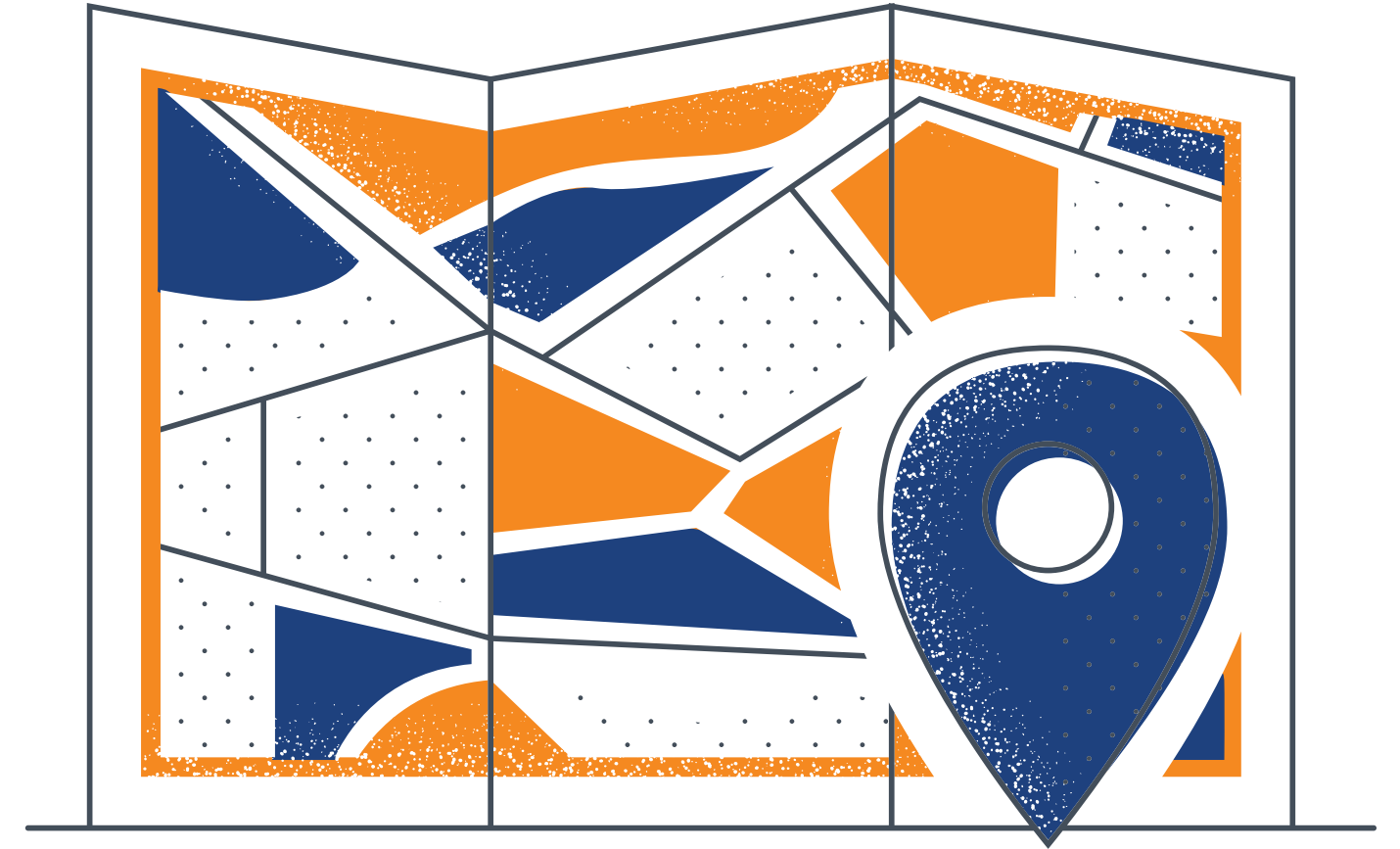


Our core principles and how they relate to what we accomplished in 2019 and our goals for **2020**.

- Tamper detection for JavaScript. [Scheduled for 2nd half]
- Resource Encryption for .NET applications. [Assessing]
- Cross platform tamper and debug checks for .NET Core. [Assessing]

Support Latest Platforms

We align our product development to support the latest platform features.

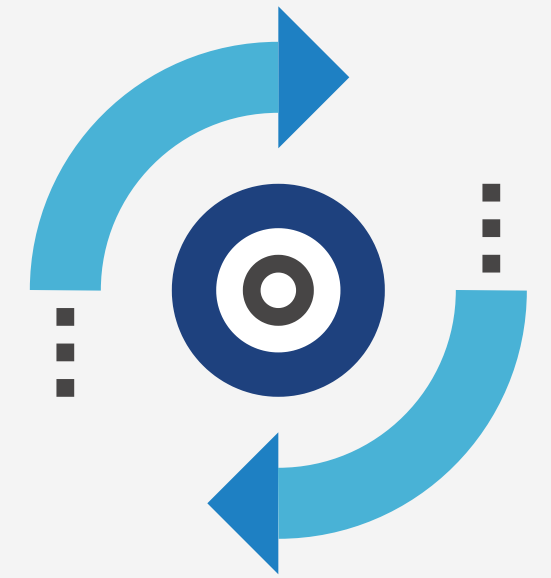
In 2019, we continued to evolve our products to support major updates to the Java, Android, and .NET platforms.

- DashO added support for Java 11, 12, and 13, and the latest versions of Android.
- Dotfuscator added support for .NET Core 3.x, and preview versions of client-side Blazor, as well as for the latest versions of Xamarin, Visual Studio, and Visual Studio for Mac.

In 2020,

major changes to Java, Android, and .NET are coming. We will be there to support them.

- Dotfuscator's automatic renaming rules for XAML-based applications will be improved. [Scheduled for Q2]
- Dotfuscator will support .NET 5. [Scheduled for 2nd half]
- DashO will support Java 14 and 15, and Android 11. [Scheduled for 2nd half]
- DashO will add features and explicit support for Spring Boot. [Scheduled for 2nd half]
- JSDefender will continue to support the latest tools, frameworks, and bundlers. [Planned throughout the year]

Modern Development Practices

Updates to better support build scenarios.

In 2019, we delivered major updates to DashO and Dotfuscator.

- DashO now has a tighter integration with the Android Gradle build pipeline, leveraging the R8 and D8 tools from Google.
- Dotfuscator now supports cloud build scenarios including Azure Pipelines and AppCenter builds.
- Dotfuscator's build engine has been ported to .NET Standard and .NET Core, and now runs on Mac, Linux, and Windows.
- Dotfuscator now integrates with Visual Studio for Mac.

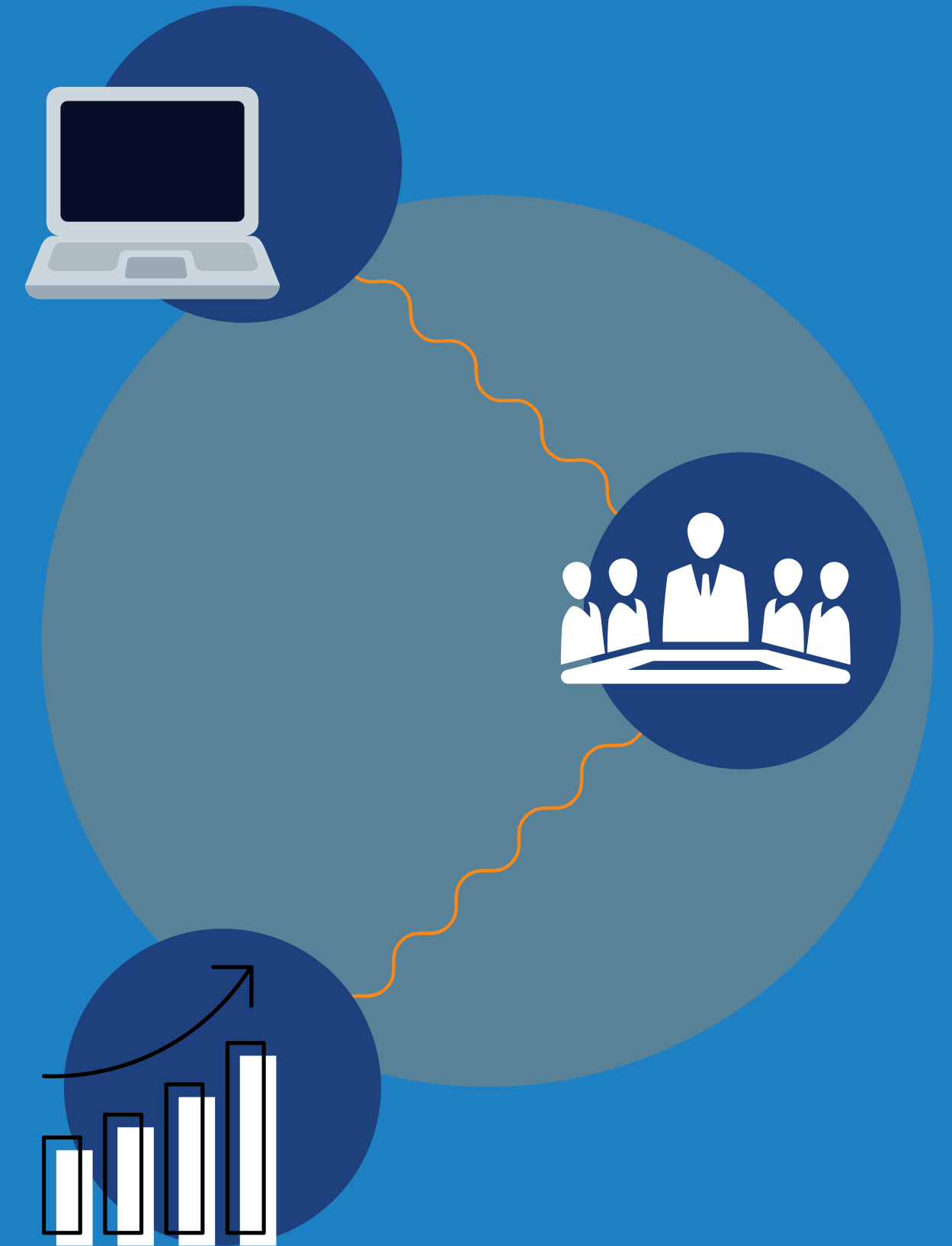
We have a renewed focus on effective product management, with the goals of keeping our products in alignment with market demands and solving real customer problems.
